Background

Adams Thermal System Foundation (ATSF) merged with the former CHSFS (Children's Home Society and Family Services). Currently, ATSF is working in the Hadiya Zone on the Western side of Ethiopia. The Adams Thermal System Foundation is helping 900 children from bitter poverty into hopeful new possibilities through two schools located in the communities of Hossana and Ottoro and empowering their family through Self Help Group (SHG) program.

1. Project name:- Education Program

Project Period:- Three years (Tir 2008 to Tahisas 2011 E.C.)

Activity Description:-Adams Thermal System Foundation-Ethiopia runs two schools in the Hadiya zone of the Southern Nations, Nationalities and Peoples Region (SNNPR).

One of the schools established in the region is located in Hossana. The second school is located in Ottoro which is found in the Hadiya zone of the south Regional state. In both schools there are 900 students. Adams Thermal Academy Hossana (ATAH) School runs from Kg to grade 10 and Adams Thermal Academy Ottoro (ATAO) school runs from Kg to grade 8. These children have come from the poorest of the poor families. Apart from the provision of proper education, they are also supplied with food, school uniform, medical services and stationery for free.

In collaboration with Geneva Global, Adams Thermal System Foundation has started implementing a program named Accelerated Learning for Africa (ALFA). This is a program designed to help older children from age 9 to 14 go to school. Children of this age group who are non-entrants or dropouts because of poverty and the loss of parents are the targets. The program offers a one year educational program for vulnerable children between 9 & 14 years of age. It compresses the first three years of mainstream primary school curriculum. There are four projects in the ALFA program. These are: ALFA class, Self Help Groups (SHGs), Child to Child program & ALFA Primary School Capacity Building Program. Even though there were several kids of the same age who haven't been to school or dropped out, the project had to come up with criteria to select the most disadvantaged
